BUILDING A GREENER FUTURE

Shop Penarth is organised by Gwyddio Greening Penarth (GPG) in partnership with Penarth Town Council, key Penarth businesses and the Penarth Times. GPG launched the scheme in 2010 to support the local economy, encourage loyalty among customers and to help keep Penarth's shopping areas alive and attractive. Most importantly, the scheme also helps cut carbon emissions because people are not using their cars to shop out of town.
